KMTA PERFORMANCE COMPETITION

*As an incentive for student growth, the Kitsap Music Teachers Association awards **cash prizes** to Kitsap music students who demonstrate outstanding achievement in performance during independently judged competitions. Prizes are awarded as follows:*

PIANO DIVISION PRIZES:

Elementary (3rd – 5th grade): 1st Place \$50; 2nd Place \$40; 3rd Place \$30

Junior (6th – 8th grade): 1st Place \$100; 2nd Place \$75; 3rd Place \$50

High School (9th-11th Grade): 1st Place \$300; 2nd Place \$200; 3rd Place \$100

High School (12th grade): 1st Place \$600; 2nd Place \$500; 3rd Place \$400

VOCAL & INSTRUMENTAL DIVISION PRIZES:

Elementary (3rd – 5th grade): 1st Place \$50; 2nd Place \$40; 3rd Place \$30

Junior (6th – 8th grade): 1st Place \$100; 2nd Place \$75; 3rd Place \$50

High School (9th-11th Grade): 1st Place \$300; 2nd Place \$200; 3rd Place \$100

High School (12th grade): 1st Place \$600; 2nd Place \$500; 3rd Place \$400
