Tentative Date Set for Kitsap Young Musicians Festival

As we all enjoy having dates on our calendars as far in advance as possible, I have been in touch with St. Antony of Egypt Church in Silverdale about reserving a day for the **Kitsap Young Musicians Festival** in the fall. The church has confirmed that **Saturday, November 4 is available**, along with the deposit amount to hold the space. I will confirm the date as soon as KMTA has a budget for 2023, including budget for KYMF.

As I mentioned at our May meeting, the registration fees for KYMF have not been raised for about 20 years. Last year, this event finished in the red, according to Jane Melin, despite having a free piano tuning by sponsor True Sound Pianos and no expense for the printed programs. It seems it's time to raise our fees. I'm recommending that individual fees be raised to \$10 and groups of five or more be raised to \$50. This should help ensure the continuance of the event on stable financial footing and help KMTA secure needed income for other events that operate in the red, such as KMTA's Christmas recitals.

Scheduling your students for the event will begin after our first chapter meeting in September. Watch for more information in your September Quavers.
